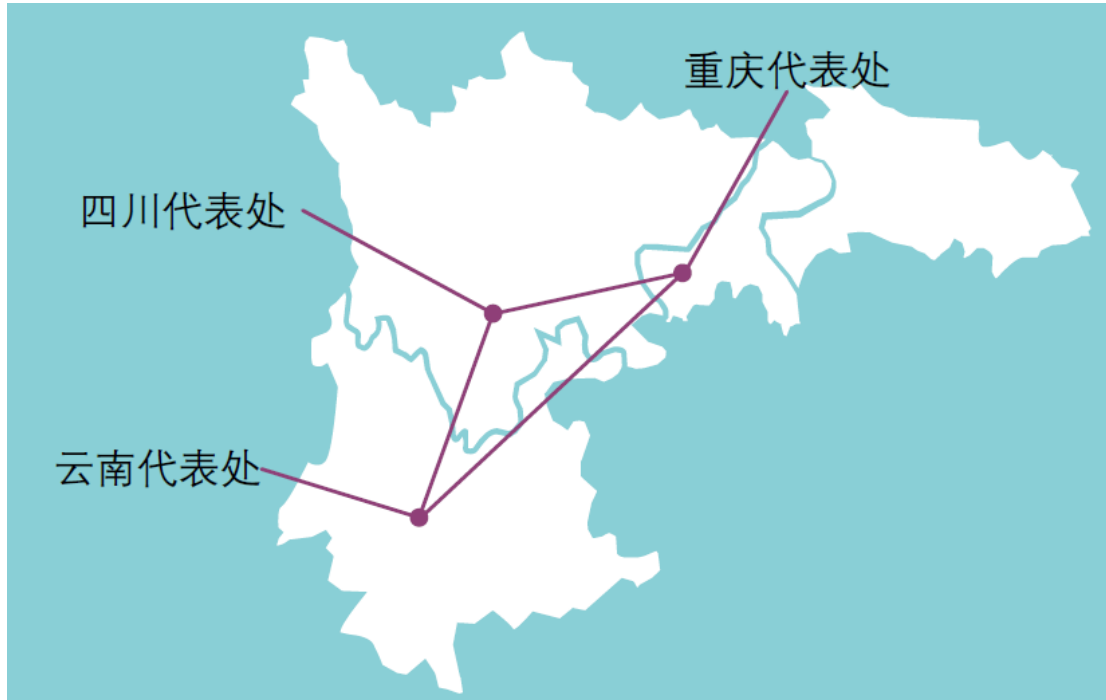


About China

China has over 16 million people living below the national poverty line of Rmb 3,300/year; 11 million children lack access to preschools and more than 20 % of children in poverty areas are undernourished. China, being #86 on the Human Development Index right after Algeria and before Ecuador - is faced with many challenges on its way forward to build a harmonious moderately well-off society.



About HPP China

Humana People to People China (“HPP China”) is an organization fighting shoulder to shoulder with The Poor - foremost in rural areas – aiming at sustainable development with an ‘Open Future’ for everyone.

Humana People to People China started as ‘Humana People to People Cooperation Project Office of Yunnan Province’ under the Poverty Alleviation and Development Office of Yunnan Province in June 2005.

Following the introduction of the 'Overseas NGO Management law' on 01.01.17 we have now three registered “The Federation for Associations connected to the International HUMANA PEOPLE TO PEOPLE Movement (Switzerland)” - representative offices' in Yunnan, Sichuan and Chongqing.

HPP China has reached over 3.3 million people since it started projects in 2007.

HPP China in numbers, 2018

In 2018 HPP China ran 13 projects, of which 6 ended in July at the end of the school year, and 2 new projects were started, so the year ended with a total of 7 projects: 1 TCE project, 1 FC project, 1 CD project and 4 POF projects.

By 31.12.2018 HPP China employed 12 full time project leaders and staff in the projects, 23 full time staff or consultants in the 3 offices to deliver project support and 88 field workers (Preschool teachers, Farming Instructors and Area leaders). The organization reached a total of 8,889 people including 237 staff and their families, 506 volunteers and 8,146 people in the programs.
