Zimbabwe is a landlocked country located in southern Africa, between the Zambezi and Limpopo Rivers, bordered by South Africa, Botswana, Zambia and Mozambique. The capital and largest city is Harare.

Zimbabwe is a country of roughly 16 million people. Minerals and agriculture are the main foreign exports of Zimbabwe. Tourism also plays a key role in its economy.

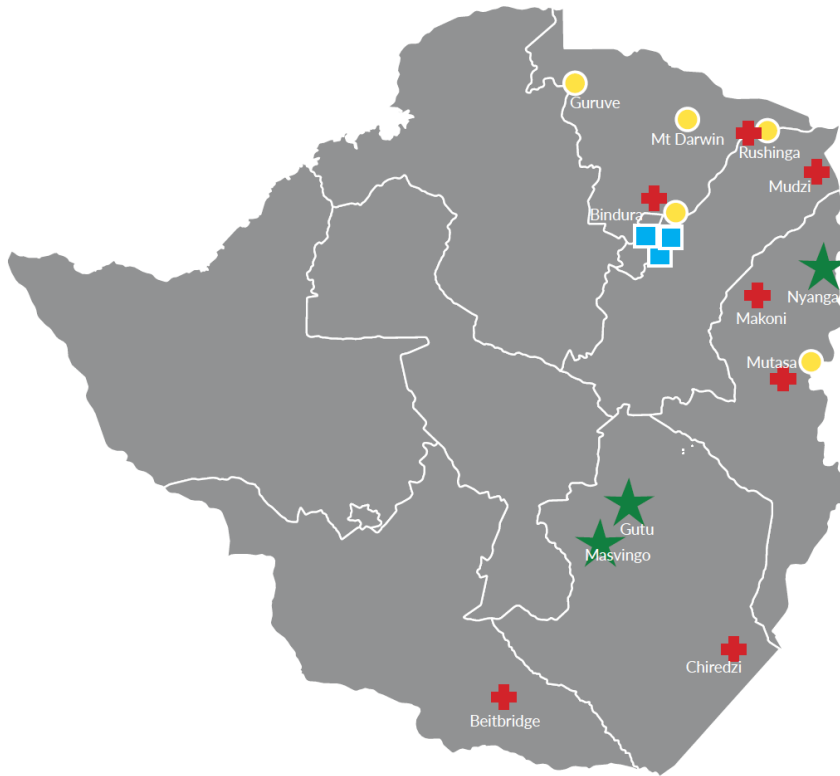
DAPP Zimbabwe in numbers, 2018

DAPP in Zimbabwe implemented 19 projects in 2018 within these sectors: Agriculture and Food Security (Farmers' Clubs Mutasa, Makoni, Gutu, Masvingo; Park Estate and Kukwanisa Model Farm), Child Aid (Child Aid Malaria, Rushinga, Bindura/Shamva, Guruve, Mutasa, Mt Darwin), Health (TC TB Makoni and Hope Bindura) and Schools (Ponesai Vanhu junior School, Ponesai Vanhu Technical College and Frontline Institute).

The projects are spread in 6 provinces of Zimbabwe which are; Manicaland, Mashonaland Central, Mashonaland East, Matebeleland South, Harare and Masvingo, where 247,000 people were reached through various activities relevant to their well-being - physically, psychologically and socially.

DAPP employed 161 employees and co-operated with 1,653 volunteers.
